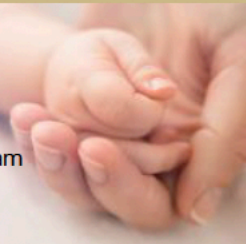

Sunshine Genetics Pilot Program

Florida's Sunshine Genetics Act puts **BABIES FIRST!**

Together, we can help ensure that every child in Florida has access to the best possible start in life, powered by the science of genomics. This program is part of a bold new vision; making Florida a national leader in precision pediatric medicine where care is personalized, preventative, and powered by genomics.



WHY IT MATTERS FOR FLORIDA FAMILIES

- Earlier diagnosis
- Timely medical intervention for babies with rare or life-threatening diseases.
- Better quality of life for Florida families

FLORIDA'S INSTITUTE FOR PEDIATRIC RARE DISEASES

1. **Parents opt-in** at selected hospitals and clinics in Florida at no cost, with written consent
2. **A small blood sample** is collected from the newborn, then sent to the Florida Institute for Pediatric Rare Diseases at FSU for screening
3. **Results of the screening** will be available to the baby's parents and expert healthcare providers to begin care as early as possible for babies at risk.
4. **If a parent chooses, anonymous data** can be securely shared with pediatric researchers to search for cures and improve future care.

FLORIDA'S INSTITUTE FOR PEDIATRIC RARE DISEASES

With only a few drops of blood, we can scan DNA for hundreds of potentially serious but treatable genetic conditions, often before symptoms appear.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Exceptional care

Collaboration between the State of Florida and Florida's universities, hospitals, and genetic experts across the country and the world to provide families with the best care and resources from the start.

Expert leadership

Research led by FSU's pediatric rare disease experts, university researchers, healthcare providers and government leaders.

Long-term impact

With permission from parents, secure anonymous data from the program will contribute to life-saving research, impacting families for generations.

BY THE NUMBERS

4-5 years It often takes 4-5 years for a child to be diagnosed with a rare disease.

1 in 10 10% of Americans are affected by rare diseases.

80% 80% of all rare diseases are genetic.

~600 600 rare diseases have potential interventions when detected early.

For every \$1 invested, families save \$4 in medical expenses.
